Changed by the Story of Jesus

Pastor Nate Kellogg I Peter 2:1-10

You and I are people of God through Jesus – and His story envelopes ours!

What is story? We don't mean fairy tale, made up story. Our story and the story of Jesus are real events in this world.

- 1. Because we have received God's Word, the words in our stories change.
 - a. This not a theoretical or emotional concept this changes the words we say. We are called to be rid of anything that doesn't fit the Story of Jesus.
 - b. Every single action listed is an effort at finding security in ourselves
 - c. So STOP doing those things remind yourself daily that your security is not in what others think of you but in <u>Jesus Christ</u>.
- 2. The whole goal of our stories change when we encounter Jesus and enter His story.
 - a. Our desire is for the <u>substance</u> of the Gospel. Which is the person of Jesus Christ found in the <u>written</u> Word of God.
 - b. Since our identities change and our hope and security is in Christ and His salvation, all of our desires change.
 - c. We crave because we have <u>tasted His goodness</u> therefore we grow into our salvation.
- 3. All of our stories become aligned with the Story of Jesus (or not).
 - a. To those who believe, Jesus is a <u>secure foundation</u> to build your new life on.
 - b. We have a choice we can come to Jesus or reject Him like others have.
 - c. Built into a <u>spiritual house</u> a place where God's Space and human's space <u>intersect</u>.
 - d. We become priests in this house that means you and I represent God to the world.

We are left with two options:

- 1. We can accept Jesus, His story and let it envelope ours and change entirely the way we look at the world.
- 2. We can deny Jesus and try to write our own story and encounter the fact that we're only stumbling around.
