1. Suffering shouldn't surprise us.

- We are called beloved because it's easy to forget when you are suffering.
- We have no <u>right</u> to <u>expect</u> better treatment <u>than Christ</u>.

2. Suffering will refine us.

- Suffering in this world makes us <u>long for heaven</u>. This world is <u>all the heaven</u> that some will ever know.
- When life is <u>uncomfortable</u> we see what we <u>really believe</u>.
- Faith that falters before the finish was false from the first.

3. Suffering gives us an opportunity to shine.

- What does it mean to bring God glory = I <u>make God look Good!</u>
- Our suffering may be someone's greatest blessing.
- Does the light shine greater in the day time or the night time?

Application:

- View your suffering as <u>an opportunity to bring God Glory</u>.
- Look for ways your suffering can bring you closer to God.
- Talk to God, don't complain to everyone else.
