#### A one-time award of RVCA \$500.00 OR Oakwood Presbyterian Endowment \$1,000

#### ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant must be a senior student attending Redbank Valley High School or a participating member of a Redbank Valley church.
- 2. Applicant must be formally accepted at a post-secondary school
- 3. Applicant must be a full-time student.
- 4. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications will only be accepted and evaluated on stated criteria.
- 5. The application must be accompanied by a Candidate Rating Scale completed by the candidate's pastor.

#### PROCESS

- 1. Students must submit application and essay to their pastor by March 17, 2017.
- 2. Pastors will submit applications, essays and Candidate Rating Scale to Redbank Valley Church Association, Attn: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 75, New Bethlehem, PA 16242 by <u>March 31, 2017</u>.
- 3. A committee will determine the recipients of the scholarships.
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded after proof of college enrollment is received by the Scholarship Committee.
- 5. Scholarships will be announced at the annual Redbank Valley High School Awards Ceremony, May 2017.
- 6. Money will be distributed to the recipients by August 15, 2017.
